

Early Childhood Educators: Lower your health insurance costs with Access Health CT.

If you're an Early Childhood Educator in Connecticut, there's new financial help to lower what you have to pay for health insurance when you enroll through Access Health CT.

You could get between \$1,000 and \$1,200 a year, depending on your income, from the Early Childhood Educators Health Insurance Subsidy to lower your health insurance costs. That's on top of any other financial help you may already be eligible for.

Who can benefit?

This new financial help from the State of Connecticut is available for Connecticut Early Childhood Educators and Professionals working at licensed child care centers, group child care homes, family child care homes, center-based programs or community child care programs. This can include:

- Preschool teachers
- Infant/toddler teachers
- Early childhood administrators
- Daycare/Child care staff
- School readiness or Head Start teachers
- Family Child Care Educator

- 1 Create an account, if you don't already have one, with the Connecticut Early Childhood Professional Registry. You will need this account to qualify for the subsidy. OECRegistry.org.

- 2 Compare plans and shop for health insurance at AccessHealthCT.com. When you apply, you will be asked if you are an Early Childhood Educator. Note: we may need your help to verify this information after you enroll, so keep an eye on your mailbox or inbox.

- 3 Enroll in a health insurance plan during Open Enrollment, starting October 23. If you qualify, the Early Childhood Educators Health Insurance Subsidy will be automatically paid to your insurance company each month.
